# Places of Interest in and around Coimbatore

Welcome to Coimbatore "The Manchester of South India" also known as Kovai, the second largest city of Tamil Nadu and one of the fastest growing cities in India. The real charm of Coimbatore lies in the balanced climate and the nature's exuberance, manifesting in a spell-binding topography of mountain ranges, waterheads, dams, resorts wild life sanctuaries and places of visitors interest. It is the right concoction for a unique tourist experience, both cathartic and therapeutic.

Perur Pateeswarar Temple is a Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Shiva located at Perur, in western part of Coimbatore, 7 km west of the Noyyal River. The temple was built by the palayakarars, under the rule of Raja Raja Chola. Lord Shiva, known as 'Patteeswarar', is the presiding deity of this temple together with his consort Parvati, who is known as 'Pachainayaki'. This temple has several gopurams and halls, famous of which is the one with the golden statue of Nataraja. The pillars have carvings of the various manifestations of Shiva and the ceiling has a series of stone chains.



**ISKCON** Temple in Coimbatore is a well-known pilgrimage centre located in the heart of the city. The ISKCON temple aims at spreading the science of Krishna consciousness with the help of Bhagavad Gita. This temple is at a distance of 5 kilometres from PSG College of Nursing. Spread across an area of 20,000 sq ft, the temple has an array of beautiful deities belonging to Sri Radha Krishna, Sri Jagannath, Sri Baladev, Subhadra Devi and Sri Prabhupada.



**Isha Foundation** is a non-profit, spiritual organisation founded in 1992 by Sadhguru Jaggi Vasudev. It is based at the Isha Yoga Centre near Coimbatore (India) and at the Isha Institute of Inner Sciences at McMinnville, Tennessee in the United States. This place is at a distance of 34 km from Coimbatore. The foundation offers yoga programmes under the name Isha Yoga. It has over 2 million volunteers. Isha activities are designed to create an inclusive culture that is the basis for global harmony and progress. This approach has



gained worldwide recognition and reflects in Isha Foundation's special consultative status with the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) of the United Nations.

Marudamalai (historically known as marudhavarai) is a popular temple of the Hindu god Murugan, situated top a hill of the same name in Coimbatore. Like most Murugan temples, Marudhamalai Murugan temple is situated upon a hill that is a part of the Western Ghats and is about 12 km west from the city of Coimbatore. Marudamalai temple was managed by Kongu Vettuva Gounder kings in early periods.

Kovai Kutralam falls is an exhilarating water fall located in the scenic region of Siruvani. The water fall is about 37 km away from Coimbatore city and the water fall is predominantly manifested for its exaltedness. The water fall is set in the deepest fragment of the impenetrable woodland and due to this reason vacationers are not conceded to visit the falls after 5 pm. The drinking water in Coimbatore is supplied by Siruvani.



**Siruvani Waterfalls:** At a distance of 42 km from PSG College of Nursing, Siruvani Waterfalls (also called Kovai Kutralam Falls) are located in Siruvani Hills in Tamil Nadu. These falls formed by Siruvani River are located in dense forest. These falls are very close to Siruvani Dam (5 km away) which provides drinking water for Coimbatore City. The water of the Dam is famous for its sweetness.



**Black Thunder:** Black Thunder Theme Park is an expansive water park in Coimbatore that covers an area of 75 acres and has an array of water-themed rides. Those looking for a splendid escape near Coimbatore in the scorching summer heat must visit the Black Thunder.



**Kovai Kondattam:** Kovai Kondattam is an amusement park located about 18 km away from PSG College of Nursing in Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu.



Brookefields Mall, Prozone Mall & Fun Republic Mall: Brookefields Mall, 7 km away from the PSG College of Nursing, is famous for shopping and recreational activities in Coimbatore. From apparel to shoes and accessories, you name it, and they have it. Prozone Mall is one of the largest horizontally designed shopping mall in India with Ground +1 structure of over 5 lakh sq ft. The mall has outlets from major clothing, apparel brands and



a 09-screens INOX Theatre. Fun Republic Mall in Peelamedu is 1 km away from PSG, Coimbatore. It is located on the arterial Avinashi Road on a 3.5 acre site. The mall has 6 levels with a total area of 3.25 lakh sq ft. The mall also features a five screen multiplex operated by Cinépolis theatre with a capacity of 1,119 seats, and a McDonald's restaurant spread over 3,470 sq ft on two floors in addition to its food court.

#### **NEARBY PLACES**

**Ooty** is 94 km from PSG College of Nursing; it is often referred to as 'Queen of hill stations'. It is the capital of Nilgiris district in the state of Tamilnadu. Nilgiris means 'Blue Mountains'. A land of picturesque picnic spots & lakes, it was a popular summer and weekend getaway

for the British during colonial days. It is situated at an altitude of 7,440 feet (2,240 meters) above sea level. Ooty Lake, Botanical Garden and Rose Garden are famous places in ooty.



**Topslip / Valparai** is 76 km away from PSG College of Nursing, located near Pollachi (TN) at an altitude of 800 feet from the sea level on the Anamalai mountain range. It is a part of the protected Indira Gandhi Wildlife Sanctuary. Topslip is blessed with a gentle altitude, salubrious climate and a vareity of flora and fauna. Its picturesque location and fabulous scenery has made it a popular location for several

movie sequences. It stands majestically with Green Spread Mountains and forest all around. It is a Project Elephant sanctuary and a Project Tiger sanctuary. The local administrative control is with the Forest Range Officer under supervision from the Wildlife Warden at Pollachi.

**Palakkad** is at a distance of 52 km from PSG College of Nursing. Also known as Palghat, it is a town and headquarters of Palakkad district in the state of Kerala. Palakkad, the Granary of Kerala, is one of the top Kerala tourist places. Palakkad is one of the most popular tourist destinations in Kerala with several Waterfalls, Dams and Sanctuaries. Palakkad Fort, Jainmedu, Kalpathy, Malampuzha Dam and



Gardens, Pothundi Dam, Meenkulathi Bhagavathi Temple, Pallassena and Dhoni Waterfalls are the famous tourist places in Palakkad. The district is gifted with the beauty of virgin and verdant Nelliampathy hills, Silent Valley National Park, Parambikulam Wildlife Sanctuary, Attappady hills and Mangalam, Kanjirapuzha, Siruvani and Parambikulam Dams.
