## The House of Delegates Express Satisfaction at Progress of TNAI

The long-awaited event of TNAI, the 23rd meeting of the House of Delegates (HoD) was conducted on 30 April 2022 after the National EC & Council decision to this effect, at Hotel Radisson Blu in Greater Noida, NCR Delhi. Due in 2020, it was deferred in the wake of the-then all-pervasive coronavirus pandemic. The HoD meets every alternate year, usually concurrently with TNAI Conference, to (re)consider and endorse the decisions of National EC & Council. The meeting was attended by 219 members representing 30 States/UTs, Defence services, National Office bearers, National Executive Committee members, National Council members and House of Delegates.

The highlights of the meeting included presentation of TNAI activities and achievements from December 2018 to April 2022, budget and brief financial report of TNAI, issues and amendments related to Bye-laws of TNAI and SNAI. The reports, amendments and other proposals were unanimously approved by the members. In the afternoon, the members were taken around the RMNCH+A Skills Lab, International Training Centre (ITC), and the National Nursing Museum (under construction) in TNAI's Central Institute of Nursing & Research Centre and Elderly Day Care Centre in Greater Noida (UP). The members finally visited the TNAI Headquarters at Green Park, New Delhi, and got an orientation of various departments and sections of TNAI. The members were satisfied and happy at the progress of TNAI.

**Nurses Day Celebrated at TNAI HQrs:** In remembrance of the legendary nurse Florence Nightingale, the International Nurses Day (IND) is celebrated the world over on 12 May 2022, her birth anniversary. The IND was organised on this day at TNAI Headquarters by Delhi State Branch of TNAI. The TNAI National President Prof (Dr) Roy K George was the chief guest and Prof (Mrs) Bimla Kapoor, former Director, School of Health Sciences IGNOU & Chairperson NNMC 2020 was the guest of honour.

## The TNAI House of Delegates Meeting: A Report

The House of Delegates (HoD) meeting of TNAI is being conducted every two years since 1974. After December 2018 HoD meeting in Goa, next one was due in the year 2020. However, it could not be held due to the-then pandemic condition.

Accordingly, consequent upon decision of the EC/Council in its meeting held on 12-13 March 2022, the 23rd House of Delegates meeting was conducted on 30 April 2022. The venue was Hotel Radisson Blu, Greater Noida, NCR Delhi.

**Participants and Agenda:** A total 219 members from 30 States/UTs and Defence services - National Office bearers (10), National Executive Committee members (15), National Council members (26), House of Delegates (168) attended this meeting. The agenda for the 23rd meeting of House of Delegates was: consideration of the biennial reports, passing of the biennial accounts, approval of biennial budget, amendments of Rules and Regulations in TNAI and SNAI Bye-Laws.

Conduct of Meeting: The meeting started with the invocation song followed by one minute silence to pay homage to all Covid martyrs who sacrificed their lives in discharge of their duty during the Covid-19 pandemic. Mrs Evelyn P Kannan, Secretary-General TNAI welcomed the august gathering and honoured Prof (Dr) Roy K George, the National President TNAI with the ceremonial Presidential Chain of TNAI. Mrs Sanghamitra Sawant, Assistant Secretary-General TNAI briefed about the attendance of the National Office bearers, National Executive Committee members, National Council members and House of Delegates from all the States across India.



Brief introduction about this special HOD meeting was given by the Secretary-General. Referring to the transactions of combined TNAI National Executive and Council decision held on 12 & 13 March 2022, she said that many hon'ble executive committee members had raised the need to conduct House of Delegates meeting as envisaged in TNAI constitution, to ensure that all the activities and initiatives are supported by customary approval of the association as a whole. The HoD meetings held along with Biennial National Conference and select members across the country had the advantage of attending the TNAI Conference which was of educational nature. Since National conferences were not held due to pandemic, National EC and Council members questioned the propriety of travelling such long distances for one day's HoD meeting. With TNAI Conference postponed to February 2023, it was not befitting to delaying the HoD meeting till that point of time. In view of this situation, and the expenses involved, it was decided that States/UTs will pay 50% of TA (economy



flight fare/2 tier AC-train) for HoDs meeting and other 50% of TA along with boarding and lodging will be borne by the TNAI Headquarters. To control the expenses, it was also decided unanimously to select 25% of the strength of HoD from each State or UT Branch.

Abiding by the above National EC & Council decision, the number of HoD was calculated according to the Membership status of each State/UT branch by the TNAI Headquarters and the same was communicated to the Branches. The Branches selected the HoDs and submitted the list duly signed by the Branch President and

Secretary. HoDs strength of each branch was calculated as per the total membership as on 31 December 2021.

Then, the Secretary-General requested the National President TNAI to preside the meeting. Prof (Dr) Roy K George, National President TNAI in his address outlined that in keeping with the truly transparent and democratic mechanism of TNAI's working, it was considered essential to apprise the representative members (HoDs) about the developments in preceding years. To ensure maximum participation of HoDs travelling expenses were borne by the Association first time in its history. He requested the members to deliberate seriously on matters presented and approve the same only if they viewed that the decisions or amendments presented were beneficial for the nursing profession, the Association and the society at large. He noted and appreciated that first time such a high percentage of selected HoDs are attending the meeting. He thanked each HoD for their enthusiasm and support to the Association.

Highlights of TNAI activities and achievements from December 2018 to April 2022 were presented by Mrs Evelyn P Kannan, Sec-





retary-General TNAI. Budget and brief financial report was presented by Mrs P.K. Bamra, Hony Treasurer, TNAI. TNAI Bye-laws points for amendments were presented by Mr Ajinas AM, Assistant Secretary-General TNAI and SNA Bye-Laws points for amendments presented by Mrs Vatchala Dhinakaran, Assistant Secretary-General TNAI. Discussion on the matters submitted to HoDs was led by the National President, TNAI. The reports/ amendments and other proposals were unanimously approved by the members.

Post-lunch all the members first visited the TNAI's Central Institute of Nursing & Research Centre and Elderly Day Care Centre at Greater Noida (UP) premises of TNAI; here, they visited the RM-NCH+A Skills Lab, International Training Centre (ITC), and the National Nursing Museum (under construction). Afterwards, they all visited the TNAI Headquarters at Green Park, New Delhi, where they got an orientation of all the departments and sections of TNAI. The members were back to the hotel which was followed by dinner.

Mr Anirban Sarkar, GM, Radisson Blu sent a note to us, "... we thank all of you for your dedicated service and hard work for the nation during those unprecedented times... [and] consider [hosting you] as honour... [for an] opportunity to serve you". As a goodwill gesture he also offered cake to the participants.

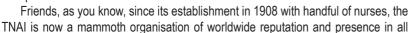


## HOD MEETING OF TNAI HELD AT HOTEL RADISSON BLU, GREATER NOIDA ON 30 APRIL 2022

## Address by National President TNAI, Prof (Dr) Roy K George

Distinguished guests and Friends!

I am very happy to welcome you and present a brief outline of how your organization fared in last few years especially after the last HOD meeting was held on 13 December 2018. Given the rich, dedicated and committed legacy of your Association, and a strong force of about five lakh members, a pool of nursing experts and good wishes of veterans like you, I foresee a vibrant, bright and beautiful future for the organization and ipso facto all those with stakes in it.





States & UTs with around five lakh members including ANMs, GNMs and Nursing students. All these years, it has been steadily moving on & on towards its mission of enhancing professionalism, welfare of nurses in general and members in particular, and contributing to national health schemes & programmes through its own and collaborative activities. As natural, there have been odds, but your organization could tide over the rough times by its hard work and hard working in unison towards a shared vision.

Admittedly, our progress in preceding two Corona years viz. 2020 and 2021 abated due to lockdowns and social distancing that were essential to keep the pandemic at bay. Consequently there was stagnation in new memberships too, the major source of our revenues. But with the undeterred spirit we managed to continue our educational programmes in online mode as the conditions warranted. As a modest contribution to bring relief in tough Corona period, we planned and distributed surgical masks and other essential items in underserved areas through our State Branches. Our meetings and training programmes were conducted using high capacity e-platform of TNAI. In fight against Corona, we lost many nurses including some of our brave member-warriors too. A big salute to them! With Corona now apparently on the wane and normalcy resuming, we hope to more than make up for the loss incurred in two-year period. To mention some of recent developments:

- Under the scheme of Research Grant for TNAI members, grants were released to nine members in 2021, and applications for 2022 are being now invited.
- To expand the training activities, Skills Labs are sought to be established in four regions of TNAI.
- Other decisions, already taken by EC/ Council held last month are: sponsoring (i) coaching of five nurses for Civil Service Examination in New Delhi; (ii) TNAI members for Faculty Development Programme.
- Developing QR code for payment of various fees and donation payment to TNAI to facilitate money transactions.
- Taking up the issues of (i) establishment of Nursing Directorate at National and State Levels; (ii) initiation of Nursing Cadre at national and state level institutions; (iii) travel concession for National Florence Nightingale Awardees in Indian Railways with the respective authorities.
- Acknowledging the importance of strengthening students wing, the SNAI, the EC/Council recommended revision
  of SNAI bye laws to create more leadership positions for Student Nurses in SNAI. The SNAI units shifting to (New)
  SNAI-TNAI Membership plan are also being offered incentives like a Modular Skill Trainer Mannequin by Laerdal to
  active SNAI Units.
- Appointment of Assistant Secretaries in selected States as approved by EC/ Council in meeting held recently.
- The 14th reprint of TNAI's popular publication, 'Community Health Nursing Manual' was released on 4-5 September 2021.
- Launch of online version of Nursing Journal of India (NJI) that shall enhance it visibility. In case any of you may not
  be aware, NJI happens to be one of the three oldest nursing journal brought out consistently ever since, without
  interruption.

This august gathering may be aware about the upcoming TNAI National Biennial Conference in February 2023. The venue of same is yet to be decided.

I consider myself fortunate to have been part of this great organisation in crucial and testing period. I affirm my commitment to the cause TNAI stands to the best of my ability in times to come.

We at TNAI express our heartfelt gratitude to the respected HOD members whose support and guidance continue to inspire and guide us to keep on working incessantly towards the vision of TNAI.

## Guidelines for TNAI's National Nurses Research Grant- (TNNRG)

## 1. Eligibility Criteria

- a. Life membership(s) of TNAI (Minimum Two years of active membership) is mandatory.
- b. BSc/MSc/ PhD in Nursing
- c. Experience in independent research is preferable
- d. Experience in guiding research is preferable
- e. In case of a research by a team of professionals in which non nursing members are included, the primary researcher shall be a TNAI member as per criteria (1.a) above. But in any case, all nurse researchers in the team shall be TNAI members.

#### 2. The Research Focus

Studies related to Nurses Welfare, Nursing Management, Nursing Standards, Assessment/Innovation/Experiment/Improvement of Nursing Services and Education.

## 3. Population

The study should cover ideally a wide range of Population (State, Region) and not limited to a single institution.

## 4. Application and Proposal

The investigator(s) shall submit the Research Grant Application in the prescribed Performa along with the detailed proposal and the budget.

#### 5. Recommendation

The application shall be recommended by the State/UT Branch President and the Secretary.

#### 6. Research Grant

- a. TNAI National office after due consideration by the research committee may accept or reject the application at their discretion.
- b. TNAI can decide whether it can be fully funded or partially funded.
- c. Funding may be released in instalment, say 50%, after preliminary submission of proposal and Ethical committee clearance. Next 25% upon completion of study and final 25% after submitting the written document along with soft copies.

d. Can be directly funded from National office to the Individual/Group or the research organisation.

## 7. Duration of the project

Research Study must be time framed (A time plan to be submitted by the Principal Investigator)

- a. 1 Year
- b. >1 Year to 2 Years

Note: Studies planned for a period more than 2 years are not preferable.

## 8. Review of progress

Review of Progress will be done by TNAI National office at least once in every six months. The investigators shall submit the progress reports once in 6 months.

#### 9. Publication

Studies conducted under the auspices of TNAI must and will be the intellectual property of TNAI and shall be published in NJI only.

#### 10. Recognition (Mandatory)

The investigator shall document and recognize the financial support from TNAI in all communications/reports/publications related to the study.

The eligible candidates can apply for the research grant by sending the proposal and application through email or post.

मनुष्य सिंहत सभी जीवों व वनस्पित जगत तथा प्रकृति के बीच ऐसा तालमेल है कि एक के कुशल रहे बिना दूसरा ठीक नहीं रह सकता। यों भी कह सकते हैं दोनों एक दूसरे पर पूर्णतया निर्भर हैं। इस बुनियादी सिद्धांत की अवहेलना से मनुष्य वायु, जल के साधनों और इनके प्रयोग से खिलवाड़ करने लगा है जिससे पर्यावरण संतुलन डांवाडोल हो रहा है। लान्सेट कमीशन की हालिया प्रकाशित एक अध्ययन के अनुसार प्रतिवर्ष विश्व में 90 लाख समयपूर्व मौतें पर्यावरण के प्रदूषण से हो रही हैं। पर्यावरण के संरक्षण के प्रति जन जागरूकता में अभिवृद्धि के लिए यूएनईपी (सं.रा. पर्यावरण कार्यक्रम) के तत्वाधान में 140 से अधिक देशों में 5 जून का दिन विश्व पर्यावरण दिवस के रूप में मनाया जाता है। इस वर्ष का थीम है, जो भी है, बस एक पृथ्वी ही है। आशय है कि हमारे खेती, उद्योग, रहनसहन, निर्माण गतिविधि आदि की कोई भी गतिविधि पृथ्वी के स्वास्थ्य को हानि तो नहीं पहुंचा रहे। समझना होगा, प्रकृतिविरोधी कार्य करेंगे तो अंततः हमारा जीवन दुष्कर हो जाएगा।

## **ACADEMIC YEAR 2021 - 2022**

The Trained Nurses' Association of India (TNAI) invites applications for award of SNAI Scholarships for the academic year 2021-2022.

Scholarships are available for the following courses:

- 1. ANM Programme / Multipurpose Health Workers (Female)
- 2. Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery.
- 3. Basic BSc Nursing.

## I. Eligibility Criteria

- 1. The applicant should be a bonafide student of a School/College of Nursing (recognised by Nursing Council/regulatory body).
- 2. The SNAI unit recommending the candidate for the Scholarship should be an active Unit for at least last **three years**.
- 3. The applicant should not be receiving any financial support/benefits from any other source by way of stipend / fellowship / scholarship, etc.

#### II. General Instructions

- 1. Application forms should be recommended and signed by
  - a) Unit SNAI advisor of the institution
  - b) Principal /Head of the Institution.
- 2. The selected awardee will be provided with Rs. 24000/- as one time scholarship.
- 3. The completed application forms addressed to: The Secretary-General, The Trained Nurses' Association of India, L-17, Florence Nightingale Lane, Green Park, New Delhi-110016, should be sent to TNAI Headquarters on or before **August 31, 2022.**
- 4. Applications received last or incomplete, shall not be considered.

#### Note:

- 1) Students of academic year 2021-2022 (1st year only-admitted between June 2021 to March 2022) are eligible to apply for the SNAI Scholarship.
- 2) Each SNAI Unit can forward maximum two applications only from each category i.e. ANM, GNM and B.Sc.(N).
- 3) The SNAI unit applying for scholarship should have enrolled all former students to TNAI after successful completion of their course (SNAI to TNAI membership), if they were/are following the old scheme of SNAI membership.
- 4) The SNAI annual subscription fee should have been paid for the entire batch of students in the institution, if the institution is following/opting SNAI subscription plan (old scheme).
- 5) Recommendation of the Unit SNAI Advisor and the Principal is mandatory.
