The TNAI's National Executive Committee Meets at Vaikom (Kerala)

The 107th meeting of the National Executive Committee (EC) of TNAI was conducted on 22-23 July 2022 at Kalathil Lake Resort, Vaikom (Kerala). Twenty-five EC members from 13 States attended the meeting. It was presided over by Prof (Dr) Roy K George, National President of TNAI. Various issues related to growth of profession and Association were taken up for discussion in the meeting.

The date and venue for the forthcoming TNAI Biennial Conference viz. Kalakshetra Auditorium (Panjabari area) in Guwahati (Assam) during 30-31 January 2022, was discussed and announced. Considering the unsatisfactory working conditions of nurses working in non-government sector, the EC members have decided that writ petitions to this intent be filed in the respective States across the country. Considering that many TNAI State branches do not have their own premises, it was agreed that all State/UT should endeavour to purchase land in a phased manner so as to expand and strengthen their activities.

The EC members desired that the Indian Nursing Council may be approached to consider changing the nomenclature of BSc Nursing to BSN (i.e. Bachelor of Science in Nursing).

The contribution of Nurses during pandemic Covid has been universally acknowledged, some of them even lost their life in bringing relief to the affected. With this reality in view, the EC suggested to build a Covid Memorial Wall at TNAI's Greater Noida campus as a mark of honour to the Covid martyrs.

With TNAI in its role of recruitment agency for nurses abroad and considering that USA looks forward to nurses from India, the EC deliberated and approved that collaboration with concerned organisations may be made for recruitment of nurses from India to the USA.

As a move to invigorate its presence in Asia region, the EC also decided that a half day virtual conference be organised for members of CNMF Asia region. The meeting adjourned with thanks to the chair.



Orientation Programmes for Chandigarh UT and Goa State Branch Executives

In line with the earlier decision by the TNAI's EC at its meeting to orient the Executive Committee members of TNAL State Branches about the functioning of TNAI, the executive members from Chandigarh UT branch participated in the oneday orientation programme on 12 July 2022 and Goa State Branch participated in the two days orientation programme on 19-20 July 2022 at TNAI Headquarters and its Greater Noida campus. The purpose of this initiative was to impart them broad



knowledge about the role of various units of TNAI. Many of the executives stated that this was their first ever visit to TNAI Headquarters.

After welcome address, there was orientation to TNAI and SNAI and briefing on TNAI's role as recruitment agency. The broad areas covered in the orientation were: Growth of TNAI and SNAI over years; Update TNAI membership & Recruitment services; Update on SNAI & Publication; Orientation about land purchase, Accounting/Auditing; Orientation about agenda, Minutes & State branch report; Orientation about the TNAI staff and the job responsibilities being handled by them including maintenance of files; visit to various sections of TNAI Hqrs. The executive members observed the multiple activities of TNAI with great interest and expressed satisfaction at the professional working of each unit.

The participants were shown a live demonstration of the BLS, ACLS training.

The Trained Nurses' Association of India (TNAI) invites applications for award of SNAI Scholarships for the academic year 2021-2022.

Scholarships are available for the following courses:

- 1. ANM Programme / Multipurpose Health Workers (Female)
- 2. Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery.
- 3. Basic BSc Nursing.



क्यों जरूरी है मच्छरों से बचाव

दुनिया के अधिकांश इलाकों में पाया जाने वाला नन्हां सा मच्छर, विशेषकर बरसात में, स्वास्थ्यकर्मियों और डाक्टरों के लिए चुनौती बन जाता है। इसके काटने से मलेरिया, डेंगू, चिकुनगुनिया, जीका वायरस, येलो फीवर, फिलैरिएसिस, वैस्ट नाइ वायरस जैसी भयंकर बीमारियां हो सकती हैं। संक्रमित मच्छर के काटने से प्रायः हल्के या मध्यम कोटि की तो कभी गंभीर बीमारी हो सकती है। एक कड़वा सच यह है कि अकेले मलेरिया से विश्व में प्रतिवर्ष ७.८१ लाख व्यक्ति जान गंवा देते हैं।

मलेरिया से निजात दिलाने में ब्रिटिश चिकित्सक रोनाल्ड रॉस की ऐतिहासिक भूमिका रही। उन्होंने २० अगस्त १६०२ को मादा मच्छर के काटने मलेरिया होने की खोज की, इसी निमित्त उन्हें मेडिसिन में नोबल पुरस्कार से नवाजा गया। फलस्वरूप चिकित्सकों के लिए मलेरिया की जानकारी, पहचान, और इसके इलाज का मार्ग सहज हो गया। उनकी स्मृति में २० अगस्त का दिन विश्व मच्छर दिवस के रूप में मनाया जाता है।

मच्छर अपने शिकार खोज लेते हैं: शारीरिक ऊष्मा, गंध आदि के जिरए मच्छर मनुष्यों तथा अन्य जीवों द्वारा सांस से उत्सर्जित कार्बन डाईऑक्साइड की ओर आकृष्ट होते हैं। गहरे रंग के करीब वे जल्दी आते हैं। खड़े पानी में मादाएं अंडे देती हैं। अतः बरसात में मच्छरों से बचने की विशेष तौर पर जरूरी रहता है। नर मादा तो फूल-पौधों के रस से काम चला लेते हैं किंतु मादाओं को अंडे देने के लिए रक्त की आवश्यकता रहती है।
