## **TNAI Goa State Branch Elections 2025**

**(Extract of TNAI Bye Laws related to State/UT Election)**

### **1. List of office bearers in the State/ UT Branch executive committee**

- I. State President
- II. State Vice-President
- III. State Secretary
- IV. State Joint Secretary
- V. State Treasurer
- VI. State SNAI Advisor (Teaching faculty only eligible)
- VII. Chairperson – Nursing Education and Research Section.
- VIII. Chairperson - Programme Committee
- IX. Chairperson - Membership Committee
- X. Chairperson - Public Health Nursing Section (Public Health Nursing Personnel only eligible)
- XI. Chairperson- Nursing Service Section (Hospital/ Clinical Nursing Personnel only eligible)
- XII. Chairperson - Socio-Economic Welfare Committee
- XIII. Chairperson - LHV/ANM, State Branch (Only LHV/ANM personnel eligible)

### **2. Common Eligibility Criteria for the State/ UT Branch Office Bearers**

- i. Any candidate filing nomination for State/ UT Offices shall have completed a minimum of **05 years** of membership in TNAI.
- ii. Age: Shall not have completed **66 Years as of 1st of January** of the calendar year in which the election is notified.
- iii. Any member holding the highest nursing position (Education/ Service) in the State (Government/ Regulatory/ Statutory bodies) is not eligible to contest for the State/ UT Offices of TNAI.
- iv. Any member who has previously held/ served the national office(s) positions in TNAI shall not contest State/ UT offices.
- v. No TNAI member shall be in the State Executive Committee for more than 20 years. Out of these 20 years, the maximum period for holding the post of President/ Secretary of the branch is up to a maximum of 16 years.
- vi. For those members getting coopted to the state EC, this 20-year period is not restrictive as they do not have voting rights and/or executive powers. Coopted members serve state EC only in advisory capacity.
- vii. Any TNAI member who held 2 consecutive terms (08yrs) as President or Secretary or both the positions in 4 years consecutive term each (total 08 years) as President or secretary shall have a break of a minimum 4 years to contest the post of President or Secretary in the State Branch.
- viii. The current/ previous President or Secretary of the branch shall not contest any other executive positions in the State/UT ie, TNAI members who held the post of President or Secretary of the State/UT branch can contest only for the post of President/ Secretary in the future term subjected to the conditions in the clause number v and vii.
- ix. In any case a TNAI member can have a maximum of 16 years as President or Secretary in the State Branch. This is to ensure that no TNAI members shall exceed 16 years term in the National Council.

### **3. Eligibility for contesting in the various offices of State/UT:**

#### **(i) State/UT President:**

Any life member of TNAI working and residing in the State/UT branch and who served one term (04 Years) as a State executive member at any time in the State/UT is eligible to contest for the post of President of the State/UT Branch.

**(ii) State/UT Secretary**

- a. Any life member of TNAI working and residing in the State/UT branch and who served as State executive for one term (04 Years) at any time in the State/UT is eligible to contest for the post of Secretary of the State/UT Branch.
- b. The office of the Secretary is reserved for female TNAI life members only.

**(iii) State/UT Vice President**

Any life member of TNAI with 05 years of TNAI membership may submit a nomination for the post of Vice President of the State/UT Branch.

**(iv) State/UT Joint Secretary**

Any life member of TNAI with 05 years of TNAI membership may submit a nomination for the post of Joint Secretary of the State/UT Branch.

**(v) State/UT Treasurer**

- a. Any life member of TNAI with 05 years of TNAI membership may submit a nomination for the post of Treasurer of the State/UT Branch.
- b. The office of the State/ UT Treasurer is reserved for female TNAI life members only.

**(vi) State/UT SNAI Advisor**

- a. Any life member of TNAI with 05 years of TNAI membership may submit a nomination for the post of SNAI Advisor of the State/UT Branch.
- b. The office for the State/ UT SNAI Advisor is reserved for Nursing faculty working and residing in the respective state only.

**(vii) State/UT Chairperson- Nursing Education and Research Section**

- a. Any life member of TNAI with 05 years of TNAI membership may submit a nomination for the post of Chairperson- Nursing Education and Research Section of the State/UT Branch.
- b. The office for the State/ UT State/ UT Chairperson- Nursing Education and Research Section is reserved for Nursing faculty working and residing in the respective state only

**(viii) State/UT Chairperson- Programme committee**

Any life member of TNAI with 05 years of TNAI membership may submit a nomination for the post of Chairperson- Programme committee of the State/UT Branch

**(ix) State/UT Chairperson- Membership Committee**

Any life member of TNAI with 05 years of TNAI membership may submit a nomination for the post of Chairperson- Membership committee of the State/UT Branch

**(x) State/UT Chairperson- Public Health Nursing Committee**

- a. Any life member of TNAI with 05 years of TNAI membership may submit a nomination for the post of Public Health Nursing Committee of the State/UT Branch.
- b. The office of the State/ UT Chairperson- Public Health Nursing Committee is reserved for Community Nurse/ Public Health Nurse/ Public Health Nursing officers working and residing in the respective state and working in the Public Health/ Community Health setting.

**(xi) State/ UT Chairperson- Nursing Service Section**

- a. Any life member of TNAI with 05 years of TNAI membership may submit a nomination for the post of Chairperson- Nursing Service Section of the State/UT Branch.
- b. The office for the State/ UT Chairperson- Nursing Service Section is reserved for Nursing Staff working and residing in the respective state and working in a hospital/clinical setting.

**(xii) State/UT Chairperson- Socio-Economic Welfare Committee**

Any life member of TNAI with 05 years of TNAI membership may submit a nomination for the post of Socio-Economic Welfare Committee of the State/UT Branch.

**(xiv) State/UT Chairperson- LHV/ ANM**

- a. Any associate life member of TNAI with 05 years of TNAI membership may submit a nomination for the post of LHV/ ANM of the State/UT Branch.
- b. The office of the State/ UT- LHV/ ANM is reserved for female TNAI associate life members only.

**4. Common Instructions regarding nomination for the various posts in the State/ UT Branches of TNAI.**

- i. A member filing nomination shall be a member working and residing in the respective State/UT branch of TNAI. If the candidate is working, the place of work shall be in the same State/ UT area. An exception may be given to the members living in the NCR region of Delhi but working in the NCT of Delhi. In such cases, the members are not permitted to transfer the membership for 04 years. Also, the member shall give an affidavit to that effect to the RO.
- ii. The nomination form shall be **filled and completed by the candidate** i.e. with the complete address pin code and TNAI number of the candidate along with the consent and declaration duly signed. The nomination form shall be proposed and seconded by the TNAI member.
- iii. The office positions for Chairperson- LHV/ANM are to be nominated only by Associate Life Members of TNAI i.e. Members with ANM/LHVs qualifications. The Life Members of TNAI are eligible to nominate for all other positions i.e., Members with GNM and above qualifications.
- iv. The nomination form submitted shall be supported by a self-attested photocopy of the TNAI life membership photo ID card of the contestant, proposer, and seconder.
- v. The details of the contestant, proposer and seconder such as name, photograph and signature mentioned in the nomination sheet shall match with the records of TNAI membership system to be considered as accepted nomination.
- vi. The contestant can submit any number of nominations for any one of the offices in the TNAI State/UT Election.
- vii. In case of more than one nomination for the same office, the proposer and seconder shall not be the same.
- viii. The proposer and the seconder can nominate only one person for a particular office. In case a proposer and the seconder proposed or seconded more than one candidate, the earliest application received to TNAI Hqrs will be considered valid.
- ix. The proposer and seconder for a candidate filing nomination shall be residing in the same state or UT as domicile or working and life member of TNAI.
- x. All valid nominations for the State/UT President and Secretary shall be included in the Provisional Ballot Paper/ Electronic voting device and published in the TNAI bulletin and TNAI website. The order of the names in the nomination sheet shall be as per the **alphabetic order of the first name** of the candidates.
- xi. For other offices the names of the three members having the highest number of nominations shall be included in the Provisional Ballot Paper/ Electronic voting device.
- xii. All office bearers who have completed the term of office are eligible for reelection for one more term.
- xiii. A break of 04 years after two consecutive terms (08 years) is necessary for the State/ UT President/ Secretary to contest for the post of President/ Secretary at the State level.
- xiv. A break of 04 years after two consecutive terms (08 year) is necessary for any other executive members of the State/ UT to contest for the any other posts in the State level except for the post of State/ UT branch President/ Secretary.
- xv. In any post, a member in the State can hold the State offices for a maximum of 16 Years only.
- xvi. Any person who has been expelled from a position in State Office, shall not be eligible to contest for any position in TNAI.
- xvii. Members who are, or had been involved in litigation with the Association are not eligible to contest election.
- xviii. The office bearers of a dissolved State/ UT branch are not eligible to contest for a term of **FOUR** years.
- xix. The members holding office positions in TNAI shall not hold office positions in parallel Nursing Organizations (like trade unions, other associations or societies). For filing a nomination to the TNAI post, the members will have to relinquish the post in other nursing organizations. The accepted resignation letter from the head of the parallel organization shall be submitted to TNAI headquarters through the respective TNAI State/UT Branch.
- xx. The person so elected for a particular office at the State/ UT level shall hold the office for the full term (four years) and shall not contest and cross to another office before completion of the term of their existing elected office.
- xxi. The members who are residing outside the Country/ State/ UT shall not be eligible for contesting election.



- i. The open election will be conducted **on the day of election** along with the scheduled Rajasthan State branch Election.
  - ii. Nomination sheet is available in the TNAI National and the Rajasthan TNAI State Website.
  - iii. Eligible members for the open positions are required to download and print the nomination sheet.
  - iv. The Nomination form duly filled / completed by the candidate i.e. complete address, TNAI number along with the signature shall handed over to the Returning officer of the Rajasthan State branch at the election venue **on the day of election** on or before 09.30 AM physically.
  - v. The nomination form duly submitted shall be supported by self-attested photocopy of TNAI life membership photo ID card of the contestant, proposer, and seconder.
  - vi. Nomination for Chairperson ANM/LHV shall be proposed and seconded by TNAI Associate Life Members only.
  - vii. The proposer and seconder for a candidate filing nomination shall be residing in the same state or UT as domicile or working and life member of TNAI.
  - viii. A copy of the working and residing proof shall be submitted along with the nomination.
  - ix. A copy of the employment proof shall be submitted by the eligible candidates contesting for **Chairperson- Public Health Nursing Section**.
  - x. For the vacant offices, the names of the **three members having the highest number** of nominations only will be included in the electronic voting device.
  - xi. If only **one nomination**, then it shall be **declared as Elected** by the Returning officer.
  - xii. If more than one member for the positions, election for the position shall be initiated and declare the most voted member as Winner.
- G. Instruction to the Contestants:**
- i. Each contestant is requested to submit the name of the representative (who can observe the entire polling and counting process) to the Returning Officer **before 09.30 am on the day of election**. The nomination of the representative shall be submitted in the prescribed form with the name and TNAI number of the person nominated as representative.
  - ii. The prescribed form for the nomination of a representative is available in TNAI National and Rajasthan State Branch or can be obtained from the returning officer.
  - iii. Only a life member of TNAI from the Rajasthan branch is eligible to be the representative of the candidate.
  - iv. Each representative will be given an authorization card which shall be displayed by the representative while attending the work as a representative of a candidate.
  - v. Representatives are allowed to be present in the designated place as directed by the Returning officer and are not allowed to move to other areas of the polling booth. They can talk or raise any issues to RO/ TNAI officials on election duty only.
  - vi. In any case, they shall not talk to any voter/contestant inside the polling station i.e. before/ during/ after casting the vote.
  - vii. It is the responsibility of each contestant to ensure authorized representative in the polling station(s) from the beginning of the voting till the announcement of the result.

**H. Instruction for the voters for the day of the election**

- i. Only Life Members of TNAI working or residing in Rajasthan are eligible to vote.
- ii. Members are requested to check their membership status at [https://election.tnaionline.org/ Update Data/ Index](https://election.tnaionline.org/UpdateData/Index).
- iii. On verification (by any member as per clause 2 above) if a member working or residing in Rajasthan finds that his/her membership is enlisted in a different state, they can transfer their membership to Rajasthan **on or before 30 days** of the actual voting using the below link. Proof of workplace or proof of residence shall be submitted along with a request for shifting of membership from other states to Rajasthan. **Link: <https://election.tnaionline.org/UpdateData/Index>**
- iv. Members enrolled on or before **13<sup>th</sup> November, 2025** are only eligible to cast their votes.
- v. Request for change of the status of membership (transfer of membership from any state branch to Rajasthan) **will be permitted till 13<sup>th</sup> November, 2025, 4:30 pm after that, any change of address request will not be accepted.**
- vi. Election will be held on **14<sup>th</sup> December, 2025** from **11.00 AM to 05.00 PM** at Sindhu Magal, Jawahar Nagar, Near Railway Station, Udaipur-313001, Rajasthan.
- vii. All voters are requested to bring their TNAI Photo identity Membership card provided by the TNAI Headquarters/ Download the **TNAI Mobile App and show the membership through the App for the verification.**
- viii. The TNAI members intending to vote shall report before 05.00 PM on the day of polling at the polling stations and get the queue token number for voting at the respective counter.
- ix. No canvassing is permitted on the day of the election inside the premises where the election and General Body Meeting is taking place. No one shall distribute slips or notices or anything else to this effect on the polling day.
- x. However, if a member uses a slip or paper bit/chit in order to counter-check/confirm the name of the candidate(s) she/he desires to vote the same is permissible.
- xi. However, contestant(s) or voters shall not show it/ handover/ distribute slip or paper bit/chit to anyone on the designated polling area or GBM area on the election day.
- xii. No electronic gadgets (mobile phones, cameras) are permitted during the voting. If any Voter is carrying a mobile phone, he/she must place it in front of the desk or table on which the computer or tablet used for electronic voting is placed so as to ensure that the mobile phone is not used while casting votes.
- xiii. No person other than the voters shall be permitted within the area of the polling booth except the designated officers/representatives/Volunteers for the election.
- xiv. The voters shall not be allowed to enter the voting area before or after the scheduled time of voting (11.00 AM to 05.00 PM).

**I. Instructions for Digital Voting**

- i. Get your queue token number at the entrance gate.
- ii. Attend the general body meeting.
- iii. Line up outside the polling station according to the token number after GBM.
- iv. At the verification counter, show your membership details. The polling officer will verify your membership and take your digital signature.
- v. You will receive two QR code slips with your TNAI membership number, name, and state.
- vi. At the verification counter, scan your QR code.
- vii. The polling officer will verify the QR code and collect the tellers slip and mark your index finger with indelible ink.
- viii. The voters will then direct to the digital polling station which is available.
- ix. The voters shall enter the QR code Token number in the digital voting screen.
- x. After the submission of the Token number mentioned in the QR code, the ballot paper will be displayed on the digital voting screen.

- xi. Life members with LMT category are eligible to cast vote for all the offices except Chairperson ANM/LHV.
- xii. Associate Life members with LMM category are eligible to cast vote only for **Chairperson ANM/LHV position.**
- xiii. Scroll through the options in the digital voting machine and click on the contestant's photo for each post.
- xiv. After selecting candidates for all posts, click the final submit button.
- xv. A confirmation of your vote submission will be displayed on the screen and confirmation email will be sent to your email.
- xvi. Leave the polling station quietly.

### मधुमेह: प्रमुख समाधान बचाव है

मधुमेह (डायबिटीज) दुनिया की एक गंभीर स्वास्थ्य चुनौती है। करीब 50 करोड़ से अधिक लोग मधुमेह की समस्या से जूझ रहे हैं, यह संख्या आगामी 30 सालों में दोगुना हो जाने की संभावना है। मधुमेह के इस सर्वव्यापी बीमारी के प्रति को जागरूक करने और बचाव के बारे में जरूरी उपाय अपनाने के उद्देश्य से हर साल 14 नवंबर का दिन विश्व मधुमेह दिवस बतौर मनाया जाता है। डब्ल्यूएचओ और इंटरनेशनल डायबिटीज फाउंडेशन द्वारा संयुक्त रूप से प्रायोजित 14 नवंबर के पीछे इस दिन सर फ्रेड्रिक बैंटिंग का जन्मदिन है, जिन्होंने मधुमेह के उपचार में इंसुलिन की खोज से रोगियों को भारी राहत दिलाई थी।

कारण: शरीर में ब्लड शुगर का अनियंत्रित होना मधुमेह का कारण है। ब्लड ग्लूकोज/शुगर आपके शरीर को मिलने वाली ऊर्जा का मुख्य स्रोत है। अग्न्याशय द्वारा बनाया जाने वाला एक हार्मोन है इंसुलिन, जो ग्लूकोज को कोशिकाओं में जाने और ऊर्जा प्रदान करने में सहायता करता है। जब शरीर में पर्याप्त इंसुलिन नहीं बन पाता या शरीर इंसुलिन का अवशोषण नहीं कर पाता है, तो ग्लूकोज कोशिकाओं तक नहीं पहुंच पाता है, और शरीर में इंसुलिन की कमी हो जाती है। यही मधुमेह है। शुगर का स्तर बढ़ने से शरीर में अनेक गंभीर समस्याएं उत्पन्न हो सकती हैं। मधुमेह के रोगी को कई बीमारियां लगने की संभावना रहती है।

पिछले कुछ दशकों से मधुमेह रोगियों में काफी तेजी आई है और क्रम जारी है। बच्चों से लेकर बड़े और बुजुर्ग सभी इसकी चपेट में आ रहे हैं। एक चिंताजनक विषय यह है कि मधुमेह से ग्रस्त व्यक्ति को कोई अन्य बीमारी लग जाय या वह दुर्घटनाग्रस्त हो जाए तो इलाज दुष्कर हो जाता है।

टाइप 1 डायबिटीज रोगियों के अग्न्याशय में इंसुलिन बहुत कम या बिल्कुल नहीं बनता है। रोगी में डिहाइड्रेशन, वजन कम होने और स्ट्रोक की आशंका रहती है; आंख, किडनी और हृदय को बहुधा क्षति पहुंच सकती है। टाइप 2 डायबिटीज इंसुलिन प्रतिरोध का सबसे आम प्रकार है। इसके तहत, ब्लड शुगर का लेवल हाई नहीं होता है लेकिन सामान्य भी नहीं होता है। यह आजीवन रहने वाली बीमारी है किंतु इंसुलिन के सही उपयोग से इसे नियंत्रित कर सकते हैं। उल्लेखनीय है कि जीवनशैली में सामान्य उपाय अपना कर डायबिटीज पर नियंत्रण किया जा सकता है।
